KAFOU LESPWA AND REOS PARTNERS: CREATING A SHARED VISION FOR HAITI

BUILDING A PLATFORM FOR CHANGE

The country of Haiti has long faced societal challenges including political crises, poverty, and food insecurity. To respond to these issues, a network of citizens launched a platform for change known as Kafou Lespwa (Crossroads of Hope) with the goal of transforming Haiti into a more equitable and prosperous country.

The group invited Reos Partners to guide their efforts to collaborate and co-create solutions to their country's complex challenges. Together, the team convened Haitians from all areas of society — politicians, activists, artists, youth, unionists, and more — to express their concerns and align a shared vision to reimagine their country's future.

THE REOS PARTNERS APPROACH

Using transformative scenarios, developed by Reos' Adam Kahane, participants were empowered to share their views on current realities, leading to the development of scenarios for different possible futures. This method enabled the group to widen their system understanding and to hold strategic conversations for change.
